Pre-Conference activities

The pre congress activities will take place in Delft from June 24th to June 26th. The activities include a symposium (the new delta flume), short courses (experiencing laboratory techniques, coastal zone management, LES applications in environmental hydraulics) and a workshop (morphodynamics with vegetation).
